The clutch engagement spring noted above is fabricated of a different material which has a higher resistance to fatique and corrosion. Corrosion has proven to be a particular problem for operators engaged in agricultural application, since the chemicals used are in many cases highly corrosive and in turn, induce hydrogen embrittlement with resultant spring breakage.

The new spring is dimensionally interchangeable with the old part and is usable on all models. The manufacturer recommends that all owners and operators obtain the new part whenever replacement of the spring is necessary; the part is available and may be ordered from the Parts Department.
